HIGHLIGHTS OF THE YEAR

(SEPT 2023 - AUGUST 2024: A YEAR OF SPIRITUAL GROWTH AND MILESTONES)

As we celebrate our 12th year in ministry, we look back on the past year with hearts full of gratitude and awe for all that God has accomplished in and through us. This year has been marked by powerful encounters, spiritual growth, and significant milestones that have set the stage for the next phase and face of our ministry.

Here's a look at how the last year unfolded:

September 2023: Supernatural
Awakening in UNIBEN

The year began with a stirring towards the students of the University of Benin and a powerful move of God at the UNIBEN Supernatural Awakening, held on the 15th and 16th of September 2023. The two-day event was a meeting filled with mighty insights from God's Word and practical demonstrations of the things of the Spirit. Hearts were stirred, and a consciousness of the supernatural power of God was birthed among those who attended. The event was a significant spiritual milestone, setting the tone for the months following.



• December 2023: Night of Prophetic Worship and End of Year Service

2023 ended with two significant events: the Night of Prophetic Worship on December 26th, and the End of Year Service on December 31st. The Night of Prophetic Worship was an evening filled with spiritual songs, psalms, and prophetic utterances, where the power of God was tangibly present. This event was not just a music concert but a profound encounter with the divine, leaving participants with a renewed sense of worship. The End of Year Service was a time of gratitude as we received prophetic words and instructions for the year ahead. It was a service of edification and we were given a strong foundation for 2024 with words.



November 2023: LTEN Camp Meeting -Heaven on Earth

From the 21st to the 25th of November 2023, we gathered for the much-anticipated annual LTEN Camp Meeting, and this year, it was tagged "Heaven on Earth." It was five days of glory and power with God's men Reverend Eghosa Alvin Osunde, Reverend Kolawole William Ogoigbe, and Reverend Chris Segun Onayinka, where passion for God's work was stirred and encounters with the God-kind left us transformed. People came from different cities and states in the country to fellowship together and left with a mighty impartation of the Spirit. Our Reverend's new book, "Healing Yourself," was also launched, providing believers with practical steps to receive healing for themselves. This book became a significant resource for members, reinforcing our commitment to healing and health.





February 2024: Celebrating Pastor Esther Isoken Osunde

On February 28th, 2024, we had the honor of celebrating our Pastor and Mother, Pastor Esther Isoken Osunde. Her motherly love, care, and pastoral guidance have been a pillar of strength for the ministry, and the celebration was a moment to express our deep appreciation for her leadership and dedication.

• March 2024: General School of Ministry and Relocation to a New Venue

March 2024 was a month of significant transitions and spiritual growth. From the 29th of March to the 1st of April, we held The General School of Ministry (GSM), themed "God's Man." This meeting was in itself an encounter with God, where attendees experienced diverse manifestations of the Spirit and were equipped for the work of the ministry. We still refer to this meeting because of the impact it had on our lives. We caught a vision of God's plan for the Earth and our place in it.

In conjunction with this event, we moved to our new worship center at **Plot 27 and 28 Precious Palm Royal Road**, **Isiohor**, **Benin City**. It was not just a move to another rented place but to the first of our properties. This relocation marked the beginning of a new phase for our ministry, and the GSM was the first meeting held in our new venue, symbolizing a fresh start and a renewed commitment to our mission.

New Service Times and Moving Forward

With our move to the new venue, we also established new service times to accommodate our growing congregation. Sunday services now commence at 8:00 AM, Wednesday services at 4:00 PM, a General Prayer Meeting is held on the first Friday of every month at 4:00 PM, and cell meetings are now held on Saturdays at 5:30 PM. In line with the word for the new year to pray every day, we established a prayer chain involving various cells and circles so that prayers would offered in the Church venue daily. These changes reflect our commitment to providing consistent opportunities for spiritual growth and community.

• April 2024: Celebrating Reverend Eghosa Alvin Osunde

April 15th, 2024, was a day of celebration as we honored our Pastor, Reverend Eghosa Alvin Osunde, on his birthday. As we reflected on the numerous testimonies of changed lives under his leadership, our hearts were filled with honour and gratitude. His teachings and example have been a constant source of inspiration and growth for the entire ministry.

We also began our mission to the city of Abeokuta

May 2024: Healing Meeting.

The year progressed with a powerful Healing Meeting on May 6th, 2024. The tangible power of God was in demonstration as miracles abounded. We saw all manner of pains, diseases, and terminal diseases cured by the power of God. This meeting was a testament to God's mercy and goodness towards us in giving us the gift of healing as a charisma and in the form of men



In the quiet town of Benin, a seed was planted.

It was the 8th of September, 2012, a day like any other, yet destined to be unlike any that had come before. Beneath the shelter of a modest gathering, hearts were stirred, minds were opened, and a vision was born.

It was called **Truth Experience'**, but it was more than a meeting; it was the first chapter in a story that would touch countless lives.

This is the story of **Light of Truth Equipping Network (LTEN)**, a tale of faith and transformation in pursuit of the divine mandate.



At the heart of the Light of Truth Equipping Network lies a sacred vision: "to teach a people truth by revelation, equipping them to be all God wants them to be, raising up a people who do the father's will and demonstrate the supernatural power of God and His Kingdom".

It's a vision rooted in revealing the truth of God's word and the reality of the Christian life, activating believers into the supernatural, and interconnecting people, giftings, and ministries under the headship of Jesus.

Under the leadership of Reverend Eghosa ALvin Osunde, the vision is brought to life within the five arms of the ministry working together in a diverse, yet singular system.

- **Truth Experience**, where people gather to be transformed by an encounter with the Spirit and the Word.
- **Christ Revolution** awakens people to who they are in Christ and what they can do and equips them to do the work of Christ.
- **Truth to the Nations,** spreading the Truth across borders into every nation, beginning from our sphere of influence to the ends of the Earth.
- Flames and Wisdom Network, where believers are taught to live by the wisdom of the Gospel so they are representatives of Christ in the world.
- **LTEN Schools and Fellowship**, training believers through various programs and building a fellowship of ministries for Kingdom expansion.

THE PATH OF PURPOSE: OUR STORY

Over the years, these arms have become vessels of transformation, hosting powerful meetings. From the soulstirring Truth Experience and the revolutionary Christ Revolution to Supernatural Activation Meetings across the nation, each meeting has left an indelible mark on the lives of attendees. Others (of no lesser quality) are Leadership Summits, Wellspring of Wisdom Conferences, Prayer Schools, Vision Seminars, the Annual General School of Ministry, and Camp Meetings, School of Biblical Studies, Masters Retreat, He Healed Them All Conferences, and the Night of Prophetic Worship.





It all began on a sunny afternoon, September 8, 2012, when a small group of believers gathered under two almond trees for the first Truth Experience meeting. The theme was simple yet memorable: *"There is a place in God."*

Just a month later, on October 8, 2012, they came together for another powerful meeting titled *"Grace for Healing."* These early gatherings, held once a month, alternated between the UNIBEN Basement Field and the Nursing Hostel.

Then came the ministry's first big gathering-a free Camp Meeting from November 15-17, 2012, themed **"PROPHETIC RETREAT:** You can all prophesy." It was held at the CPM Campground in Egba, Benin City. Those who attended left changed, prophesying, and carrying with them the fire and purpose that would fuel the ministry's journey for years to come.



GROWTH AND EXPANSION (2013-2016)

From 2013 to 2016, the ministry's growth was steady and purposeful. The monthly Truth Experience meetings quickly became a weekly gathering held in different venues, like the Basement Field at UNIBEN and CGMi, House of Praise in Irhirhi. Eventually, the Basement Field became their consistent spot until 2017. It was a place where believers would gather to be taught for hours and leave rejoicing at the encounter with the Truth and Life, Christ Jesus. Though the meetings were held under open skies, they never had to worry about the weather. Time and again, just as dark clouds gathered and rain threatened to pour, a simple word of command was spoken and the skies would clear.

A pivotal moment came on February 7, 2015, when the ministry expanded with the launch of Christ Revolution at CGMi, House of Praise. In that first meeting, something extraordinary happened: two young ladies were taught to work a miracle on a broken standing fan. To everyone's hearing, the once noisy fan was silenced by a word of command. This left everyone in awe for never had they seen such a thing done and set a high expectation for what God would do in future Christ Revolution gatherings.

Week after week, the budding community witnessed the practical demonstrations of God's power through the president, and what was thrilling was that they were activated to do the same. Fellowship flourished as they grew, not just in numbers, but in unity and purpose. Occasionally, they would come together to share the Gospel and win souls for Christ. Prayer schools became a cherished part of their gatherings, where they learned to pray by precept and example.

As their numbers increased, so did the strength and communication of their faith. Each disciple could interpret the Bible, prophesy, and work mighty miracles. Their lives were living testimonies, and the stories of God's work among them spread far and wide.



By 2017, the ministry moved to the *Haven Hotel* along Uwagboe Road in Ugbowo, Benin City. This period saw significant moments in their history, starting with the first General School of Ministry from March 27-31, 2017, at CPM Campground in Egba. The year also saw the beginnings of other special meetings such as Leadership Summit under the Flames and Wisdom Network, Vision Seminars, Wellspring of Wisdom Conferences, Night of Prophetic Worship, and School of Biblical Studies.

In 2018, the ministry began to spread its wings beyond its local roots. Through the **Truth to the Nations arm**, they organized , starting in Warri on February 23-24, then in Lagos on May 4-5, and others in the coming years. Each meeting extended their reach and impact, lighting a fire in believers to operate in the supernatural and spread the Gospel.

By April 2019, the ministry had found a new nest at the **Obey God Foundation Center**, Ogbegie Street, Ugbowo, Benin City. This move brought growth as the focus on equipping believers to preach the Gospel and demonstrate the supernatural became even more intense.

Truth Experience meetings were held on Saturday at 11 am and Christ Revolution Meetings at 3 pm on Saturdays, while other special meetings were held on Mondays and Tuesdays by 4 pm. The ministry operated in an interdenominational and non-denominational manner. Believers came from various ministries, were trained, and sent people back to their local churches with a renewed passion for the Gospel and the power of God. As a result, new ministries were birthed, pastors founded works for Jesus, and leaders emerged in different cities and nations, strengthening their local churches and spreading the message far and wide.



NAVIGATING CHALLENGES AND CONTINUING GROWTH (2020-2022)

When the world was thrown into chaos by the **COVID-19 pandemic** in 2020, the ministry faced one of its biggest challenges yet. With gatherings restricted, they adapted by holding closed-door meetings and establishing a cell structure that became a lifeline for many. These cells became more than just meetings, they were mini-communities where members could lean on each other, grow spiritually, and find support.

As the ministry navigated the challenges of 2020, they embraced a new chapter when they emphasized accountability and membership. This shift marked the *birth of LTEN Local Church in Benin City*, now more than four years strong. Though the ministry had always operated non-denominationally, this emphasis allowed people to become dedicated members of the church without needing to attend elsewhere.

While some individuals chose to remain with their original congregations, LTEN gained a loyal base of members fully committed to the vision. This period also saw the formation of departments, units, and a more structured church system, laying the foundation for continued growth and unity within the community.

In 2021, the Christ Revolution meetings were adjusted from Sunday afternoons to Sunday mornings at 7am. By 2022, the ministry had expanded even further, holding two Christ Revolution services every Sunday, reaching more people than ever before.

The year also marked a significant milestone as the ministry acquired lands and began construction in May.



A NEW PHASE OF MINISTRY (2023-2024)

As 2023 rolled in, the ministry launched their *quarterly devotional* that has become a source of daily inspiration for many, with abounding testimonies both within the country and abroad. One of the year's highlights was the *"Uniben Supernatural Awakening"* meeting in September, a program that stirred a passion for the Gospel and Supernatural in the hearts of the students of Uniben with souls, mighty healings, and miracles collected for the Lord.

Then came 2024, another significant year for the ministry. *On March 29, 2024, they moved into their property at Plot 27 and 28, Precious Palm Royal Road, Isiohor, Benin City,* coinciding with the start of the General School of Ministry's 2024 edition. Alongside, they introduced *mid-week services* starting on April 3, 2024, and streamlined Sunday services to a single 8 a.m. gathering.

This move wasn't just about a new building; it represented the expansion coming to the ministry.

There has been numerical growth, wider awareness in the environs, and spiritual growth of the members. The ministry's reach has continued to expand, with *missionary work* extending to Abeokuta and plans in place for Asaba.



A LEGACY OF IMPACT

Over the years, the ministry has trained and equipped over 1,500 individuals, including pastors and associate pastors. What started as a small group in modest locations around Benin City became a strong force with national and global relevance.

With a library of over 1,000 messages on their website, the ministry has touched lives in every state of Nigeria and over 32 countries globally. Their YouTube Live meetings have garnered tens of thousands of views, further expanding their reach. Their publications (devotionals, manuals, booklets, and magazines) have also been channels to bring the vision of LTEN to multitudes across the world.

Yet, beyond the numbers and milestones, *their greatest legacy lies in the lives transformed.* People who were once rejected and dejected have been saved and equipped to become mighty tools in the hands of the Lord. Believers and ministers, now equipped with the truth of God's Word, walk in the reality of their identity in Christ. They are confident in God's faithfulness, no longer deceived by the lies of the devil, and love the Lord relentlessly. They recognize the voice of the Lord, understand their authority, and come behind in no gifts. These individuals also excel in secular arenas, becoming giants in key sectors where they represent God and bring Heaven on Earth.

These individuals have been trained to fulfill the Great Commission: to go into all the world preaching the Gospel, discipling men, healing the sick, casting out devils, delivering the oppressed, and partnering with God to see His will done on Earth.



THE JOURNEY AHEAD

As the ministry celebrates 12 years of God's faithfulness, there is deep gratitude for the journey so far. But with that gratitude comes anticipation, a firm belief that the best is yet to come. The road ahead is filled with promise, and the ministry is poised to begin a new phase to reach even more lives and spread the light of God's word to the ends of the earth.

To more years of teaching truth by revelation, more decades of equipping men to be all God wants them to be, and raising up a people who do the Father's will and demonstrate the supernatural power of God and his Kingdom.

God's global vision for the Earth is to cover the Earth with His glory, saving one soul, one street, and one city at a time till all the Earth submits to His Lordship. The Lord Jesus gave us this mandate before He left this seen world and we are obedient to this high calling.

Through the arm of the ministry, **Truth to the Nations**, we have held several mass evangelisms, Gospel campaigns, street invasions, village outreaches, and Supernatural activation meetings to multiply God's influence in different places.

Truth to the Nations is about going to a land where the Lord sends us to do His will, which might include establishing a new work for the Lord in that place. We are not disobedient to this heavenly vision, but are as passionate about it as God intends, therefore we have established a gathering of Light of Truth Equipping Network in the western part of Nigeria, Abeokuta, Ogun state.

The mission in Abeokuta commenced on the 22nd of April 2024 with a 13-man team that also included our Sent-man, Reverend Eghosa Alvin Osunde. We set out to show the truth about the worship of God: to eliminate the shadows, and to portray God as clearly revealed in Christ to the people of the West.

With the vision being utmost in our hearts, evangelism began the next day, on the 23rd of April 2024. In the power of the Spirit, the team won over 100 souls for the Lord in two weeks, demonstrating God's love, goodness, and power.

Some of the team returned to Benin but 6 others remained, including Pastor Samuel Morenikeji, to disciple the souls won and to ensure the work grows.

After about a month, a gathering for discipleship and accountability started being held on Sunday mornings and Tuesday evenings. We can refer to those members of our family as the Church in Abeokuta.

Following the honourable example of apostle Paul, the team preached with signs and wonders all over Abeokuta for the Lord was working with them. One of the notable ones was the deliverance of a well-known madman at the Agbeloba junction, Abeokuta, Ibrahim.

"On one afternoon, while I was on my way back after our routine evangelism, I saw a madman standing at Agbeloba junction who had just harassed someone. I had walked past him, but I felt a prompt to go to him. I thought to continue on my way home to rest because I had been exhausted from the day, but then I realized that it had to be the Spirit of the Lord leading me. So, I walked back to where he was now sitting and I sat close to him. Immediately he saw me, he was taken aback and moved to attack me.

Then he said "You. I have been seeing you. what do you want from me? Do you think I don't know why you are here? what do you want from me? Leave me alone." I knew it was the demon speaking through him, so I did not engage him. I stood up and looked into his eyes fearlessly. The people around were trying to get my attention, they were screaming "He's a madman. He's going to attack you."

The demons kept talking "You are the man of God, you have come. We have been seeing you preaching." Then, I commanded the devils to come out of him. Immediately I gave the command, he became more violent and was shouting in gibberish, which drew the attention of people from a distance and a crowd started forming.




After some moments, a boy walked by The kids immediately started shouting, "ewúré! ewúré!" It was Stephen.


